



Q&A 2027 ALL THAILAND GOLF TOUR QUALIFYING SCHOOL

Q: What is the 2027 All Thailand Golf Tour Qualifying School?

The 2027 All Thailand Golf Tour (ATGT) Qualifying School (Q-School) is a two-stage tournament for golfers who do not hold ATGT membership status and for current members who want to improve their status for the 2027 season. It consists of the First Qualifying Stage and the Final Qualifying Stage. The top 40 players and ties at the Final Qualifying Stage will receive Category 16 membership for 2027.

Q: Who can apply for the 2027 ATGT Q-School?

All golfers who meet the following conditions are eligible to enter the Q-School:

- (A) Golfers who are at least 13 years old. They will be eligible to compete on the All Thailand Golf Tour in 2027 only if they are 14 years old on or before the Monday of the tournament week, or as otherwise determined by the Tournament Committee.
- (B) Male professional golfers.
- (C) Male amateur golfers with a handicap index of 5 or less, supported by a valid, unexpired handicap certificate from an accepted national governing body.

Q: Where can I apply for the 2027 ATGT Q-School?

- 1) Apply through the online application at <https://atgt.fillout.com/gschool27>
- 2) After submitting the application form, applicants will receive an email from ATGT Player Portal within 48 hours.
- 3) Log in to the ATGT Player Portal and create an account and password.
- 4) Go to the Transaction menu to pay the entry fee.
- 5) After paying the entry fee, a confirmation email will be sent. Your entry will be considered complete only after receiving this confirmation.

Q: What is the opening date for the 2027 ATGT Q-School application?

All stages open for entry on 20 August 2026.

Q: What are the closing dates and withdrawal deadlines for the 2027 ATGT Q-School?

Closing dates:

First Qualifying Stage (Section A): 30 October 2026

First Qualifying Stage (Section B): 30 October 2026

Final Qualifying Stage: 11 December 2026

Withdrawal deadlines:

First Qualifying Stage (Section A): Monday, November 2, 2026 (4:00 PM Thailand time).

First Qualifying Stage (Section B): Monday, November 2, 2026 (4:00 PM Thailand time).

Final Qualifying Stage: Monday, December 14, 2026 (4:00 PM Thailand time).

Q: When will the 2027 ATGT Q-School take place?

The 2027 Q-School will run in the following two stages:

Remarks: First Qualifying Stage (Sections A and B) - Applicants may register for either Section A or Section B, but not both. Registration and section selection are complete only after the entry fee has been fully paid. If the maximum field is reached before entries close, further applicants will be placed on the reserve list at the Tournament Committee's discretion.

Q: What is the field size of the 2027 ATGT Q-School?

Each First Qualifying Stage section is expected to have approximately 120 players. Applicants who complete the entry process correctly will be considered in priority order; section selection is complete only after the entry fee is fully paid. The Final Qualifying Stage has a maximum field of 132 players.

Q: How much is the application fee for the 2027 ATGT Q-School?

The entry fee is THB 18,000, paid once for both the First and Final Qualifying Stages through the ATGT Player Portal only. It does not include the 2027 annual membership fee, which must be paid separately before the season begins.

Q: What is the format of the 2027 ATGT Q-School?

First Qualifying Stage: Four rounds (72 holes), with approximately 120 players per section. After 54 holes, the top 70 players and ties advance to the final round. The number advancing to the Final Qualifying Stage will be announced before the First Qualifying Stage begins; all players tied for the final qualifying position will advance.

Final Qualifying Stage: Four rounds (72 holes), with a maximum field of 132 players. After 54 holes, the top 70 players and ties proceed to the final round. After 72 holes, the top 40 players and ties receive Category 16 membership for the 2027 season.

In the event of a tie, scores will be ranked by comparing the best results in the following order:
(a) 36 holes, (b) 18 holes, (c) 9 holes, (d) 6 holes, and (e) 3 holes.

Q: Where will the 2027 ATGT Q-School be held?

Both stages of the 2027 ATGT Q-School will be held at:

MANDATORY Member Seminar: December 22-23, 2026. Morning-session players attend after play; afternoon-session players attend on December 23. Absence makes the 2027 Q-School incomplete.

Ceremony Schedule: Friday, December 25, 2026, after the competition. Attendance is mandatory for the top 40 players and ties; absence makes the 2027 Q-School incomplete.

(A) Photo Shoot for All Golfers: A photo shoot will be conducted for all golfers competing in the qualifying stage at the following times and dates:

- First Qualifying Stage (Section A): November 9-11, 2026, from 08:00 to 16:00 Thailand time
- First Qualifying Stage (Section B): November 23-25, 2026, from 08:00 to 16:00 Thailand time
- Final Qualifying Stage: December 21-23, 2026, from 08:00 to 16:00 Thailand time

Q: May a player use a distance measuring device during a round in a tournament counting towards the competition?

Yes. The use of distance measuring devices (Rule 4.3a) is permitted, provided the slope function is disabled.

Q: What are the field criteria for the 2027 ATGT Q-School?

The field for the First Qualifying Stage comprises players who do not meet any Final Qualifying Stage exemption criteria.

The field for the Final Qualifying Stage comprises the following:

- Those who had exempted status in 2026 (top sixty (60) of the ATGT 2025 Final Order of Merit) but did not finish in the top sixty (60) of the ATGT 2026 Final Order of Merit and lost their exempted status for 2027 (*).
- The ATGT Order of Merit winners from 1999 who are not otherwise exempt.
- The ATGT members in positions sixty-first (61st) to one-hundred-fifty (150th) on the ATGT 2026 Final Order of Merit (*).
- A maximum of 10 players of the ATGT tournament winners from 1999 – 2024 who are not otherwise exempt.
- The leading ten (10) players not otherwise exempt and within the 1,500 ranking from the 2026 Official World Golf Ranking (OWGR) (**).
- The leading five (5) players not otherwise exempt and within the top 100 from the 2026 KPGA Tour Order of Merit (**).

- g. The leading fifteen (15) players not otherwise exempt and within the top 50 on the 2026 Thailand PGA Tour Order of Merit (**).
- h. The leading five (5) players not otherwise exempt and within the top 50 on the 2026 Asian Development Tour, India PGA Tour, Taiwan PGA Tour, China Tour, Abema TV Tour, and Philippine Golf Tour Order of Merit (**).
- i. The leading two (2) players not otherwise exempt and within the top 10 on the 2026 The Singapore Professional Golfers' Association Order of Merit (**).
- j. Nominations by the Tournament Committee at their discretion.
- k. The leading ten (10) players to a limit of 300th place in the World Amateur Golf Ranking (**).
- l. Winners of the following amateur events: a) Eisenhower Cup, b) Nomura Cup, c) Asian Games, d) SEA Games, e) Putra Cup, f) Asia Pacific Amateur Championship and g) Faldo Series Asia Grand Final.
- m. The leading five (5) players not otherwise exempt and within the top 20 on the 2026 Thailand Golf Association Amateur Ranking (Central Organization SB Class) (**).
- n. The leading five (5) players not otherwise exempt and within the top 10 on the 2026 ATGT Amateur Ranking Points.

(*) If an applicant subsequently receives an exemption for 2027, the Tournament Committee will cancel the qualifying-stage application and refund the full entry fee.

(**) As of December 7, 2026.

Q: What status will be awarded at the end of the 2027 ATGT Q-School Final Stage?

The leading 40 players and ties at the end of the Final Qualifying Stage are entitled to apply for Category 16 under the 2027 ATGT Member Exemption Categories.

Q: Who will gain ATGT membership status for the 2027 season?

The 2027 ATGT membership status comprises the following:

1	Top two hundred (200) of the Official World Golf Ranking as of the tournament application closing date.
2	The winner of any previous year Order of Merit based on accumulated performances on PGA Tour, DP World Tour, Japan Tour, PGA Tour of Australasia, Sunshine Tour and Asian Tour.
3	(a) The winner of the ATGT Order of Merit shall be able to compete in any tournament for five (5) years after the season when the golfer won this title ("5-Year Exemption"). 2022 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2023-2027 2023 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2024-2028 2024 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2025-2029 2025 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2026-2030 2026 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2027-2031 (b) Medical or Military Exemption
4	(a) The winner of Singha Thailand Masters or All Thailand Championship shall be able to compete in any tournament for three (3) years after the season when the golfer won either title ("3-Year Exemption").

5	(a) The winner of two or more tournaments within a period of one year shall be able to compete in any tournament for three (3) years after the season when the golfer won such titles ("3-Year Exemption"). 2024 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2024-2027 2025 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2025-2028 2026 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2026-2029 2027 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2027-2030 (b) Medical or Military Exemption
6	(a) The winner of any tournament shall be able to compete in any tournament for two (2) years after the season when the golfer won such title ("2-Year Exemption"). 2024 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2024-2026 2025 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2025-2027 2026 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2026-2028 2027 winner: Period of Exemption will be from 2027-2029 (b) Medical or Military Service Exemption
7	Players based on special exemptions.
8	The top players from each Monday Qualifying Tournament.
9	(a) The top sixty (60) players of the 2026 ATGT Order of Merit. (b) Medical or Military Service Exemption.
10	The top four (4) amateurs based on the 2026 of the ATGT Amateur Ranking Points.
11	The leading player within the top 5 of the 2027 ATGT Order of Merit as of the application closing date who is not otherwise exempt (applied to the next eligible tournament).
12	The leading four (4) amateurs in the top ten (10) from the 2027 ATGT Amateur Ranking Points, as of the application closing date, who are not otherwise exempt (applied to the next eligible tournament).
13	ATGT Legendary and Honorary Members.
14	The leading two (2) players in the Top fifteen (15) from the Final 2026 Thailand PGA Tour Orders of Merit.
15	Members in categories 16 and 17 shall be re-ranked according to their positions in the 2027 ATGT Order of Merit at designated times in the year, which the Tournament Committee shall determine. Note: Those members not on the 2026 ATGT Order of Merit will remain in their previous category when re-ranking occurs.

16	<i>Top 40 players and ties from the 2027 ATGT Final Qualifying Stage.</i>
17	The sixty-first (61st) to eightieth (80th) players of the 2026 ATGT Order of Merit.
18	Members in categories 19 to 24 shall be re-ranked according to their positions in the 2027 ATGT Order of Merit at designated times in the year, which the Tournament Committee shall determine. Note: Those members not on the 2027 ATGT Order of Merit will remain in their previous category when re-ranking occurs.
19	<i>Players finishing in forty-first (41st) to seventieth (70th) and ties from the 2027 ATGT Final Qualifying Stage.</i>
20	The eighty-first (81st) to one-hundred-fiftieth (150th) players of the 2026 ATGT Order of Merit.
21	<i>Player from the seventy-first (71st) of the 2027 ATGT Final Qualifying Stage.</i>
22	The one-hundred-fifty-first (151st) players and below of the 2026 ATGT Order of Merit.
23	Past ATGT tournament winners who are not otherwise exempt.
24	<i>The 2027 ATGT First Qualifying Stage players.</i>

Q: What if an ATGT member ranked 61st-150th on the 2026 Final Order of Merit elects not to compete in the 2027 ATGT Q-School?

A member ranked 61st-80th on the 2026 ATGT Final Order of Merit may remain an ATGT member in Category 17 of the 2027 ATGT Member Exemption Categories. A member ranked 81st-150th may remain an ATGT member in Category 20.

Note: The Tournament Committee will fill tournament fields according to the 2027 ATGT Member Exemption Categories. Eligibility for co-sanctioned events may be limited for lower membership categories.

Q: What are the options for an ATGT member who finished 61st-150th on the 2026 ATGT Order of Merit and has no other ATGT status for the 2027 season?

ATGT members in positions 61st-150th on the 2026 Final Order of Merit are exempt from the First Qualifying Stage and may compete directly in the Final Qualifying Stage.

Q: If I do not belong to an ATGT Membership Exemption Category and do not participate in the 2027 ATGT Q-School, can I still apply for an ATGT tournament or Monday Qualifying?

No, except by sponsor invitation. Amateur golfers who do not participate in the 2027 ATGT Q-School may still apply for Monday Qualifying, subject to the ATGT's limit on the number of amateur players.

Q: I am 13 years old and have passed the 2027 ATGT Q-School. When will I be able to compete in an ATGT tournament?

Golfers aged 13 may apply for the 2027 ATGT Q-School, but must be at least 14 years old on or before the Monday of the tournament week to enter an ATGT tournament.

Q: Can amateurs compete in the 2027 ATGT Q-School?

Yes. Male amateur golfers with a handicap index of 5 or less may apply with a valid, unexpired handicap certificate from an accepted national governing body.

An applicant may retain amateur status by entering as an amateur and waiving the right to prize money before each stage using the form available at the venue. Entering as a professional or failing to waive prize money before play may result in loss of amateur status.

Q: What is the process for reinstatement to amateur status if unsuccessful in the 2027 ATGT Q-School?

If an amateur enters the 2027 ATGT Q-School for the first time as a professional and is unsuccessful, the player may apply for reinstatement through the governing body in the player's home country. Reinstatement may be considered after three months if Q-School participation was the player's only breach of the Rules of Amateur Status (Decision 9-2b/3).

Q: Can an amateur compete on the ATGT using a result from the 2027 ATGT Q-School before becoming a professional?

No. An amateur cannot enter an ATGT tournament based on a Q-School final result. An amateur may compete through a sponsor exemption or under Categories 10 or 12 of the 2027 ATGT Member Exemption Categories.
